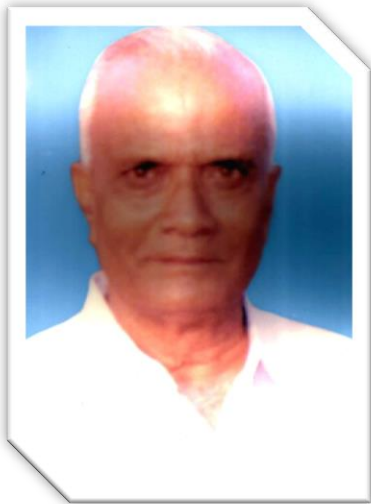


Founders and Mentors
